



### The Butterfly Effect...

A New Tool in the Field: Butterfly Ultrasound Enhances Emergency Care

Thanks to the generosity of the Trail Ridge Quilters and their incredible support of the Estes Park Health Foundation, Estes Park Health EMS now has a powerful new tool in the field: the Butterfly iQ3 handheld ultrasound unit.

This compact, advanced device connects to an iPhone via an app and allows paramedics to perform point-of-care ultrasound exams during emergency calls. It's especially useful in diagnosing trauma patients or those in cardiac arrest, providing real-time imaging that can be critical in life-or-death situations.

While this technology is still new to paramedicine, more agencies across the country are beginning to adopt it. The Butterfly app includes various modes tailored for specific uses, such as starting a peripheral I.V. or assessing internal organs, simply by selecting the appropriate setting.

Currently, Estes Park Health EMS has one
Butterfly unit. Looking ahead, we hope to secure
additional devices so that every frontline
ambulance can be equipped with this life-saving tool.

We're deeply grateful to the Trail Ridge Quilters for their commitment to advancing emergency care in Estes Valley.
